

Instructions for Submitting Your Artwork

**You are about to embark on a new adventure!
Sharing your artwork with others is exciting and easy to do.**

Read the instructions below, and then complete the Submissions Form.

First a Word About Copyrights

You are personally responsible to guarantee that your work is either original, or that you have followed copyright laws.

Anything, in ANY artistic or print media is automatically a copyright of the artist. This includes quilts based on the original design of patterns, photographs, paintings, posters, slides, drawings, etc. (even with significant changes).

If you purchase a quilt pattern or book, the "Fair Use" of it is to make quilts for yourself or as gifts. You may not sell, photocopy or share it with others.

To exhibit, display or sell a quilt using someone else's artwork, permission AND acknowledgement from the owner are required.

In Canada, copyright protection lasts for 50 years after the death of the copyright owner.

Label Your Quilt

Your quilt label should include:

- the name of the quilt, your name, and date the quilt was made

Provide Fabric Information

You are required to provide information about the fibre content of your products, under the Competition Bureau of Canada. This must be included either as a label, or on a separate sheet enclosed when you send your article to the buyer.

- The generic name of each fibre whose mass represents 5% or more of the total
- If the article consists of a number of sections differing in fibre content, identify each section and its fibre content
- If the fibre content is not known or cannot be determined, the label may show "unknown fibres" or "mixed fibres", and the %

Example: Front: 95% cotton, exclusive of decoration; (or by colour ... Red 100% cotton, Blue 100% polyester, etc.), Batting 100% wool; 80% cotton, 20% polyester; Back 100% mixed fibres.

Take A Photo

Hang your quilt vertically (hang it on the wall, and stand in front of it) and take a well-focused photo, ensuring that you do not have any glare or shadows. The overall photos MUST include all four sides (edges) and corners of the quilt.

It is helpful to include a photo of the front, the back, and a couple of close ups of detail areas. Save your digital photo(s) as .jpg only, name it with your quilt Title name, and send it by email.

Price Your Quilt

Decide what you are willing to sell your quilt for.

For pricing, we add **25%** to your asking price to determine the retail selling price.

Send Us Your Listing by E-Mail or Fax

Enter ALL information on the form attached, and fax or email t us using the "Title" in the Subject line.

All quilts are sold 'as is' so if there are any known problems with your quilt, include that information with your description, so the prospective buyer will be aware. This will reduce the possibility of your quilt being returned.

You can request that your quilt listing be deleted at any time via e-mail notice or by phone.

We reserve the right to refuse or delete your listing at our discretion, and without prior notice.

We reserve the right **not** to list any quilt that we feel will not sell, does not meet our artistic or moral standards, or that has poor photos.

By submitting you quilt listing you agree to hold **Canadian Fibre Art** 'harmless' in the event of litigation for any reason involving your quilt.

Payments / Returns / Refunds

We keep your quilt listing until it sells.

You are free to sell it yourself privately (but not elsewhere on the Web) without paying **Canadian Fibre Art** a commission. Please let us know when you sell a quilt that we have listed. If you don't get a reply

e-mail from us, please call our phone number to make sure we received your e-mail to remove the quilt listing. We do not guarantee that your quilt will sell as a result of being listed on the CanadianFibreArt.com.

If your quilt sells on [our website](#), we will pay your asking price **less** any charges for services we supplied, such as shipping, appraisals, **etc.** If your quilt is returned for a refund for any reason, you will be charged back the price you were paid.

Shipping Your Quilt

We can ship your quilt for you, or you can do it yourself. If you ship it, you will be expected to adequately box your quilt including a label and fibre information and promptly send it directly to the buyer via FedEx or UPS Priority Mail – Insured (with online tracking), with Delivery Confirmation tag.

You must send us an email with the information.
